



Greenhouses for the Colorado Homeowner

Well, we have almost made it through the winter or have we. We have a solution to this problem. Harding Nursery has begun building and selling durable greenhouses. These durable greenhouses made of 16 gauge galvanized steel or pressure treated wood, allows you to protect or grow your tender starts. It is made strong for Colorado's most adverse weather conditions. The covering is a double wall 8 millimeter thermal-glass that will protect your plants against hail, wind, and cold. Whether you prefer to grow your plants in the ground, benches, or in pots, the unit can be easily adapted. You can order these greenhouses with fan cut outs for ventilation, or supports for a small heater for those cold nights. We suggest attaching them to the ground with 6x6 pressure treated timber or concrete footer. This makes them most durable in Colorado's weather.

Here are details about the steel greenhouse:

- Galvanized 16 gauge 1.5x1.5 tube gator shield steel
- Four side welded together
- Welds painted with galvanized paint
- Thermal-glass is verolite 8 millimeter twin wall clear
- Exterior screen door-white
- H channel for 8 millimeter thermal-glass
- Nut-sert connection for easy assembly
- Clear silicone applied at joints at assembly
- Steel constructed greenhouse 8x8 @ \$2,700 plus tax

Here are details about wood greenhouses:

- Pressure treated 2x4
- Coated nails and screws
- Painted exposed ends
- Thermal-glass in verolite 8 millimeter twin wall clear
- Exterior screen door-white
- H channel for 8 millimeter thermal-glass
- Predrilled holes for lag bolt assembly
- Wood constructed greenhouse 8x8 @ \$2,100 plus tax
